ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, G. W. Gourley, John W. Rodman and Chester Gourley, have this day associated ourselves together and formed a corporation under the laws of the State of Kentucky, whose name and purposes shall be as hereinafter specified:

First: The name of this corporation is and shall be the NEW DOMAIN REALTY COMPANY.

Second: The principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be at Beattyville, Ky.

Third: The business to be transacted, promoted and carried on by this corporation is and shall be that of purchasing, owning, holding, selling and conveying real estate and other property; and said company may also acquire by lease any kind or character of property; may lease or rent on royalty or otherwise any of its corporate property; may build suitable tenement or other buildings on its land and improve and develop same in any lawful manner; may buy and sell real estate and other property on commission or otherwise; may lay off and plat cities, towns or villages in any county or state and do any act necessary to promote and build up same; may mine or otherwise extract or do any act necessary to remove and

market the coal, ores, stone and other minerals and timber from any lands owned, acquired, leased or occupied by it or from any other lands; may drill, bore and operate for oil, gas and any other minerals or metals and do any act necessary or proper to remove ~~and~~ market same; may purchase or subscribe to the capital stock of any company, or have its capital stock subscribed to or purchased by any other company; may issue its coupon bonds for any amount not exceeding the sum named in Article Eighth herein, and secure the payment thereof by one or more mortgages upon its corporate property or any part thereof, to one or more trustees for the common benefit of the holders of such bonds; may secure the payment of any debt due it by mortgage or otherwise; and shall possess and exercise all other lawful rights and powers, usual and incident to such corporations, or which may be necessary or proper for carrying out or promoting the objects and purposes of its creation.

Sixth: This corporation shall begin on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1905, and continue for a period of

fifty (50) years, unless sooner dissolved by operation of law or the voluntary act of the stockholders.

Seventh: The affairs of this corporation shall be conducted by the incorporators hereof until the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1905, at which time and annually thereafter there shall be held at the principal office of the corporation a meeting of the stockholders for the purpose of electing a board of three (3) directors, which shall have full power to conduct the business of the corporation. The Board of Directors shall select from their number a President, a Vice-President and a Secretary and Treasurer, and shall adopt suitable rules and by-laws for the government of the corporation.
