AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LOUISVILLE LUTHERAN HOME

The undersigned, being more than two-thirds of the Board of Directors or henagers of Louisville Lutheren Home, and at a meeting of said Corporation called by a majority of Directors, said undersigned being all present in person or by proxy, to consider the following amendments and by a proper resolution passed, agreed that said Articles to be amended as follows:

Article II of Amended Articles dated October 6, 1925 and recorded October 7, 1925 in Corporation Book 35, page 473 in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky are hereby amended and substituted as follows:

The object of this Corporation shall be to care for the aged members of the Lutheran Parishes of the Kentucky-Tennessee Synod and such other aged persons as the directors may see fit to consider for membership in the Yome.

Article III of the above amended Articles are hereby amended as follows:

The affairs of said Louisville Lutheran Home shall be governed and directed by a Board of Directors of not less than fifteen (15) persons selected as prescribed in the By-Laws of the Corporation from the membership of the Lutheran Farishes constituting the Kentucky-Tennessee Synod of the United Lutheran Church in America, provided, however, that not more than three shall be selected from the same congregation. The term of office of said directors shall be determined in such manner and for such time as may be provided in the By-Laws of the Corporation. A majority of the Board of Directors shall be necessary for a quorum for the transaction of business. A majority of said Board of Directors present at the annual meeting each year shall elect a President. Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, and such other officers and executive committee as it deems necessary, all to serve for one year, or until their successors are
