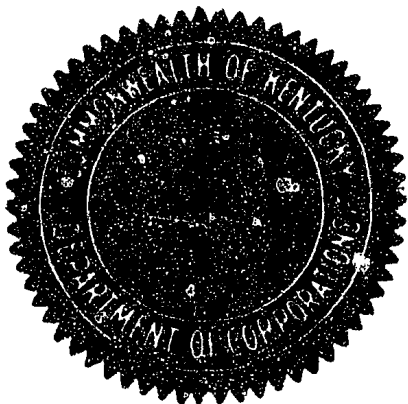

ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION
OF

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 271A.460, and KRS 271.420, et seq., the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Dissolution for the purpose of dissolving the corporation which was incorporated on December 31, 1980, which Articles were filed with the Secretary of State for the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The name of the corporation is CARDINAL JANITORIAL SERVICES, INC.

ARTICLE II

Cardinal Janitorial Services, Inc. has heretofore filed with the Secretary of State a Statement of Intent to Dissolve on April 10, 1987.

All debts, obligations and liabilities of the corporation have been paid and discharged or adequate provisions have been made therefore.
