The undersigned, G. E. GANS, and GEORGE GANS, III, being the President and Secretary, respectively, of G. E. GANS FURNITURE INDUSTRIES, INC., a Kentucky corporation, do hereby certify that the owners and holders of all of the outstanding shares of stock of said Corporation, being all of the shareholders who would have been entitled to vote upon the Amendments to its Articles of Incorporation set forth below if a meeting for such purpose had been held, have consented in writing that the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation be amended in the following respects:

FIRST: Article 1 of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended so that, as so amended, and on the whole, said Article 1 shall be and is in words and figures as follows:

"ARTICLE 1"

"The name of the Corporation is G. F. I., INC."

SECOND: Article 3 of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended so that, as so amended, and on the whole, said Article 3 shall be and is in words and figures as follows:

"ARTICLE 3"

"The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are:

- (a) To manufacture, buy, sell, deal in, and to engage in, conduct, and carry on the business of manufacturing, buying, selling, and dealing in goods, wares, and merchandise of every class and description.
- (b) To carry on all or any business of merchants whether wholesale or retail, manufacturers, jobbers, distributors, traders or agents without limitation as to the class of products and merchandise.
- (c) To manufacture, buy, sell, lease and use machinery suitable for the making, applying or using of materials and products made or dealt in by the Corporation.
- (d) To subscribe for, purchase, or otherwise acquire, hold for investment, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, exchange, distribute or otherwise dispose of the whole or any part of the capital stock or any evidences of indebtedness of any corporation, and while owner thereof to exercise any and all rights, powers and privileges with respect thereto.
- (e) To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, sell and reissue, to the extent permitted by law, shares of its own capital

stock.

- (f) To purchase or otherwise acquire, sell, exchange, hold, own, operate, lease and mortgage real estate, and to improve such real estate in any manner conducive to its better utilization.
- (g) To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, lease, pledge, mortgage and dispose of personal property, both tangible and intangible.
- (h) To borrow money, to issue, sell or pledge its obligations and evidences of indebtedness and to mortgage or pledge its assets to secure the payment of monies borrowed.
- (i) To make any guaranty respecting stocks, dividends, securities, indebtedness, interest, contracts or other obligations of any individual, partnership, association, corporation or other entity.
- (j) To acquire and hold patents, patent licenses, copyrights, trade marks and trade names and to issue licenses in respect thereto and to collect royalties thereunder.
- (k) To conduct its business and to exercise all powers conferred hereunder, and by law both within and without the Commonwealth of Kentucky and to do any and all acts and things as are necessary or convenient to the attainment of the purposes of this Corporation."

THIRD: Article 6 of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby amended so that, as so amended, and on the whole, said Article 6 shall be and is in words and figures as follows:

"ARTICLE 6"

"The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual."


