KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the Articles of Incorporation of Owensboro-Daviess County Hospital, a corporation organized under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 273.120 et seq., of Kentucky Revised Statutes, the Articles of Incorporation dated December 17, 1938, recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Daviess County Court in Corporation Book 5, page 262, on December 17, 1938, having been filed in the office of the Secretary of State on December 17, 1938, provided in Article VI that the corporation would continue for a period of fifty years unless sooner dissolved by a majority vote of its members.

Owensboro-Daviess County Hospital is governed by a Board of Directors of nine members, who exercise all of the powers of the corporation, including the power to amend the Articles of Incorporation pursuant to KRS 273.260. At a duly called special meeting of the Board of Directors held on October 28, 1963, a majority of its members gave their written consent, evidenced by affixing their names hereinbelow to this amendment of Article VI so that as amended, it shall read as follows:

WYT

"Said corporation shall commence business as soon as these Articles are filed in the office of the County Clerk of Daviess County, Kentucky, and at the office of the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in Frankfort, Kentucky. The corporation shall continue perpetually unless and until it is dissolved according to the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky."
