ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

THE BURLEY TOBACCO COMPANY OF GRANT COUNTY, KY.

- 1. The principal XXXXIXM name of the corporation shall be The Burley Tobacco Company of Grant County, Kentucky.
- 2. The principal office or place of business of the Company shall be at milliamstown, Grant County, Kentucky.
- III. The nature of the business to be transacted and carried on shall be as follows: to sell tobacco and other farm products at public or private sale as a factor and commission merchant, to store tobacco and other farm products and any other kind of property as a general warehouseman, to buy and sell real estate and personal property, also to carry on the business of redrying, curing, handling and otherwise treating and caring for tobacco and other farm products; and for the business purposes aforesaid said corporation may issue warehouse receipts, and may acquire in any manner real estate and personal property, and own, hold, use, develop, improve and dispose of same in any manner, and may sell, lease, mortgage, rledge or exchange any of its property, may loan and horrow money, and do all things usual, necessary or incidental to transacting and carrying on any of the business aforesaid.
- **20.** The amount of the capital stock shall be \$50,000.00 divided into 50,000 shares of the par value of \$1.00 each.

IX. The private property of the stockholders shall not be subject to payment of corporate debts.
