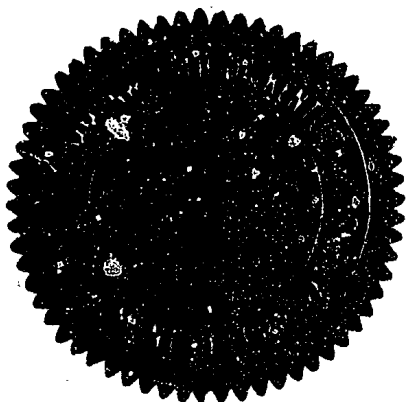

In pursuance of the provisions set out in Kentucky Revised Statute 271A.460 these Articles of Dissolution are prepared for filing with the Secretary of State for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, to wit:

1. The name of the corporation is TENNIS PLUMBING AND HEATING, INC., formerly Fred Friedmann & Son, Inc.
2. The corporation has heretofore filed with the Secretary of State a statement of Intent to Dissolve the corporation, same having been filed on or about ~~December 30, 1987~~ ²⁻¹⁰⁻⁸⁸.
3. All debts, obligations and liabilities have been paid and discharged or adequate provision has been made therefor.
4. All the remaining property and assets of the corporation have been distributed to the shareholders in accordance with their respective rights and interests.

There are no suits pending against the corporation in any court, except a suit in Jefferson Circuit Court by Metrovitch; however adequate provisions have been made for the satisfaction of any judgment, order or decree which may be entered against said corporation in any pending suit, including Metrovitch.




