Dear Mr. Davis:

We have completed the attached form to follow your request dated June 20, 1977.

Through the years we have not used the name of J. A. Stone in any reporting. For a number of yours, Mr. Stone was Secretary and Treasurer of the Trustoes of the General Assembly of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church and his home was in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Mr. Stone has been deceased for some 12 to 15 years.

In 1948, the General Assembly of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church created the Board of Finance of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, a Tennessee corporation. However, it was the feeling that, although the funds and the responsibility of the Trustees of the General Assembly were transferred by the General Assembly to the Board of Finance, there was need to keep the Charter, the oldest Charter in the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, of the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church in force. From time to time, it is easier to convey property which was deeded to the Trustees of the General Assembly and to affix our old seal in the deed and other legal matters than to try to convey the property in the name of the Board of Finance of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church.

Of course, the members of the Board of Finance are today the Trustees of the General Assembly and have been duly elected and designated to function as the Trustees of the General Assembly.

We are also attaching our check for \$5.00 and we hope this clears up all matters in connection with the Trustees of the General Assembly.
