APPLICATION FOR REINSTATEMENT OF CORPORATE CHARTER  
(STOCK CORPORATIONS)

WIDES MATERIAL COMPANY  
NAME OF CORPORATION

a Kentucky corporation whose charter was administratively dissolved under KRS 271B.15-210 or revoked under KRS 271A.615 on 11/1/94, because the corporation did not:

- File its annual report for the year(s) 1994;
- Maintain a registered agent or registered office address in this state for sixty (60) days or more;
- Notify the Secretary of State within sixty (60) days that its registered agent or registered office had been changed, that its registered agent had resigned, or that its registered office had been discontinued; or
- Change the period of duration stated in its articles of incorporation, which has expired.

The undersigned hereby applies for reinstatement on behalf of the above named corporation and further states as follows:

- (1) The grounds for dissolution either did not exist or have been eliminated;
- (2) The corporation's name satisfies the requirements of KRS 271B.4-010; and
- (3) The corporation has not wound up or liquidated its business and affairs under KRS 271B.14-050 and notified claimants under KRS 271B.14-060 and KRS 271B.14-070.
- (4) The following documents and fees are enclosed:
  - (a) A certificate from the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet reciting that all taxes owed by the corporation have been paid; and
  - (b) The Application for Reinstatement and Annual Reports;
  - (c) A check in the amount of \$ 115.00, which includes:
    - \$ 100.00 reinstatement penalty
    - 15.00 Annual Report fees for 1994
    - Amendment to Articles of Incorporation
  - (e) Add \$ 10.00 to the total listed in Section (c) ONLY IF a change of registered office or registered agent, or both, has occurred, complete the enclosed Statement of Change form.
  - (d) If needed, an amendment to the articles of incorporation to extend the corporation's period of duration.
