

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
UNITED GRAPHICS PRINTING GROUP, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, do hereby form a corporation for profit, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, specifically the provisions of Chapter 271B of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and for that purpose adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is United Graphics Printing Group, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation shall have the following powers, objects and purposes:

(a) To transact any and all lawful business for which a corporation may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Kentucky.

ARTICLE IV

The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,000 of common stock, all of which shall be without par value. Each share shall have full voting power. The Board of Directors shall, from time to time, fix the consideration for which said shares without par value shall be issued and sold.

ARTICLE V

The initial address of the registered office is 816 South Eleventh Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40210. The name of the initial registered agent at this address is Stephen W. Siegwald. The principle address of the Corporation shall be 816 South Eleventh Street, Louisville, Kentucky, 40210.

ARTICLE VI

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is one (1). The name and address of the person who is the incorporator and who is to serve as the initial director is: Stephen W. Siegwald, 816 South Eleventh Street, Louisville, KY

40210. This director shall adopt By-Laws for the corporation not inconsistent with the law of these Articles of Incorporation at the first meeting of the Board of Directors and shall have power thereafter to alter, amend, add to, or repeal in whole or in part the same.


ARTICLE VII


