Attachment to Articles of Amendment

Twin Lakes Disc Golf, Inc.

Article II

The purpose to which this corporation is organized:

To focus exclusively on educational purposes, charitable functions, as well as fostering national/international professional and amateur disc golf competitions; to encourage more players to get involved in organized disc golf by developing and maintaining disc golf courses that are appropriate for developing skilled players; to promote the development of disc golf as means of healthful recreation and physical fitness to people of all ages; to educate and uphold the rules of play and high standards of professionalism, amateurism and good sportsmanship; to assist city, county and state governments in the creation, upkeep, and installation of disc golf facilities.

Article IX

Dissolution Clause

Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to the state or local government, for a public purpose.
