Articles of Incorporation
Public Benefit Corporation

Pursuant to KRS 14A and KRS 271B, the undersigned hereby forms a public benefit corporation and for that purpose sets forth the following:

Article I: The name of the public benefit corporation is

BLUEGRASS IMPACT INITIATIVE public benefit corporation

Article II: The number of shares the corporation is authorized to issue is **100**

Article III: The name of the initial registered agent is

Article VI: The purpose of the corporation including the public benefit the corporation will provide is
Bluegrass Impact Initiative empowers communities through education, wellness, and economic development programs, fostering sustainable growth.

ARTICLE VII

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, or scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to other similar organizations that qualify as tax-exempt organizations under the federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, besides the payment of reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in

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these Articles. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall

in, intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements

proceeds to any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public
office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any
other

activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax
under the

federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation whose contributions to which are deductible under
applicable

provisions of the federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for
one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of the applicable provisions of the federal
tax code,

or shall be distributed for a public purpose to the federal, state, or local government. Any such
remaining assets shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction of the county in
which the

principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such
organization(s), as said Court shall determine.
