

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
JEFF WYLER SHELBYVILLE, INC.

The following are the Articles of Incorporation of a new corporation for profit:

1. Name. The name of the corporation is Jeff Wyler Shelbyville, Inc.
2. Purpose. The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Kentucky Business Corporation Act.
3. Authorized Shares. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,500 common shares, without par value. One Hundred Fifty (150) shares shall be designated "Class A — Voting Shares" and One Thousand Three Hundred Fifty (1,350) shares shall be designated "Class B — Nonvoting Shares". The relative rights, privileges, and limitations of the Class B — Nonvoting Shares and the Class A — Voting Shares shall be identical in all respects, share for share, except that the voting power for the election of directors and for all other purposes shall be vested exclusively in the holders of the Class A — Voting Shares, and the holders of the Class B — Nonvoting Shares shall not have any voting power or be entitled to receive any notice of meetings of shareholders.
4. Registered Agent. The name of the corporation's initial registered agent and the address of its initial registered office is Corporate Statutory Services, Inc., 820 Maple Avenue, Newport, Kentucky 41071.
5. Principal Office. The corporation's principal office shall be located at 829 Eastgate South Drive Cincinnati, Ohio 45245.
6. Incorporator. The name and address of the corporation's incorporator is Amy Brown c/o Katz, Teller, Brant & Hild, 255 E. Fifth Street, Suite 2400, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202.
