

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MKM SERVICES, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 271B of the Kentucky Revised Statutes hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be MKM Services, Inc., and its purpose is to engage in any lawful activity not expressly prohibited by the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

ARTICLE II

The street address of the corporation's initial registered office and the name of its initial registered agent at that office is 3111 Morning Park Court, Louisville KY, 40220, agent is Mike Messex.

ARTICLE III

The mailing address of the corporation's principal office is 4100 Eastmoor Road, Louisville KY, 40218.

ARTICLE IV

The name of the incorporator is Mike Messex and his address is 3111 Morning Park Court, Louisville, KY 40220

ARTICLE V

A director of the corporation may not be held liable to the corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages due to a breach of fiduciary duty, unless the breach is a result of self-dealing, intentional misconduct, or illegal actions.


ARTICLE VI

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

CONSENT OF REGISTERED AGENT
