

MINISTRY CHARTER

of

Life Training Christian Counseling

(A remote division of the National Conservative Christian Church, Inc.)

Be it known by this document that the above named ministry is an operating division of the National Conservative Christian Church, and as such shall operate and enjoy the relationship of being an integral part of this national church organization. This charter, along with the application for chartering, the charter certificate and the chartering agreement, constitute the entire relationship definition between this ministry and the National Conservative Christian Church.

ARTICLE 1.

NAME

- 1.1) Name. The name of the ministry shall be the **Life Training Christian Counseling**, and the principal office shall be 319 W. 10th Street, Suite 103, Owensboro, KY 42301.

ARTICLE 2.

Purposes and Powers

- 2.1) Purposes. The purposes for which this ministry is chartered are as follows:

- A. To disseminate the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Word of God, to the end that people may be evangelized and believers may be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ.
- B. To regularly assemble for fellowship, counsel and instruction, to worship God in Spirit and in truth and to cooperate in the building up of the whole body of Christ.
- C. To provide pastoral and human relations counseling in appropriate locations to those who need and request such ministry.
- D. To involve every participant of this ministry in its activities and in the ministry of the Holy Spirit.
- E. To strengthen the family units so that the home life of each member is healthy and fruitful by biblical standards.
- F. To create and operate a school or training facility for children, youth, and adults of all ages, for the purpose of raising their standard of life experience, spirit, soul and body. That shall specifically include, but not be limited to, a distance education program.
- G. To perform the Sacraments of the Church which include, but are not limited to, the following: to baptize believers in water; to anoint the sick with oil; to conduct weddings and funerals; to dedicate infants; and to celebrate the Lord's Supper (Communion).
- H. To act with charitable concern for, and to help, not only members of this ministry, but also all people in need of any help which this ministry can give, regardless of race, social position, or religious affiliation; to develop and carry out programs of social action for poor, widowed, orphaned, afflicted, imprisoned, underprivileged, or aged persons, both within and without this ministry.
- I. To pray for the needs of all people, for local and national leaders and governments and for all that are in authority as instructed in 1 Timothy 2:1-3.
- J. To support and encourage communication and extension of the Christian life and witness by sound and comprehensive teaching of biblical principles to all people, both within this ministry and elsewhere, not only by conventional modes, but also by all means which will accomplish such communication developed by modern technology.
