

**ARTICLE 4.
Period of Duration**

4.1) Period of Duration. This charter must be renewed annually, each calendar year. In the event of dissolution of this local ministry, no part of the ministry's assets shall inure to the benefit of any member but shall instead be distributed to the National Conservative Christian Church, Inc., a Florida corporation, as specified under Sections 170(b) and 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code as the same may be amended.

**ARTICLE 5.
Data Respecting Ministry Leaders**

5.1) The affairs and property of this local ministry shall be managed and governed by the following recognized credentialed leaders, by appointment of the Presbytery of the National Conservative Christian Church. They shall be appointed annually according to the procedure set forth in the Bylaws.

Policies and Procedures**

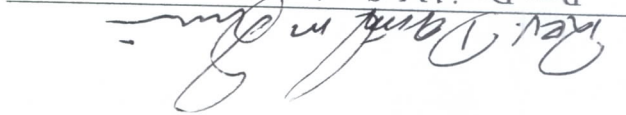

**ARTICLE 7.
Amendments**

7.1) Amendments. Amendments to this Charter may be proposed and adopted in the following manner:
Such may be proposed by either the Directors of the National Conservative Christian Church, or by the local ministry leadership, and be considered at any scheduled meeting of the Presbytery of the National Conservative Christian Church, Inc. The requested revision may be adopted only by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote.
