Exhibit A

ARTICLE VI: Purposes:

Creator Jam Company is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code including the following:

- 1) To engage in charitable activities that benefit digital and non-digital communities.
- 2) To promote the exchange of information among various stakeholders and content creators.
- 3) To facilitate educational activities related to the creation of digital and non-digital content.

ARTICLE VII: Additional Provisions:

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
