**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
VICTORIOUS VIKINGS FOOTBALL BOOSTER CLUB**

For the purposes of forming a nonprofit corporation in Kentucky pursuant to KRS Chapter 273, the undersigned incorporators hereby submit the following Articles of Incorporation to the Secretary of State for filing:

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the corporation is Victorious Vikings Football Booster Club, Inc.

ARTICLE II – NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is exclusively charitable, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE III – DURATION

The period of corporation duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV – PURPOSE

The purposes and objectives of the corporation are exclusively charitable and educational and are to seek, cultivate and obtain revenues and donations to be used for developing and expanding educational and athletic opportunities for students associated with the Valley High School Football program and teams. The corporation is empowered to fundraise, solicit, obtain, accept and receive gifts, donations, legacies and contributions, covering both property and personally property for the endowment of the corporation and for its operations; to execute any and all contracts for the essential needs of the corporation for the purpose of carrying out its purposes and objectives; and to do all other lawful acts necessary or desirable to carry out its purposes; provided however, that the corporation shall take no action inconsistent with the Kentucky Uniform Unincorporated Nonprofit Association Act or Section 501(C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

ARTICLE V – REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE ADDRESS

ARTICLE VI – DIRECTORS

The management and affairs of the corporation be vested in its Executive Board, and such committees that the Executive Board may from time to time establish. Operations in governing the corporation shall be defined by statute and by the corporation's bylaws. No Director or Executive Board member shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation. The corporation's bylaws provide the eligibility, manner of selection, duties, terms and other matters relating to the Executive Board. The executive board will consist of three positions: a President, Secretary and Treasurer.

ARTICLE VII – MEMBERS

The corporation shall have members. The eligibility, rights and obligations of the members shall be determined by the organization's bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII – EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS

No part of the net earnings corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, if any, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the

purposes set forth in Article IV, above. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Kentucky non-profit corporation; (b) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (c) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE IX – DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Executive Board shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all assets of the corporation exclusively for purposes of the corporation in such a manner as the Executive Board shall determine, to Valley High School Athletics, a department within a public school in the Jefferson County Public School District, or to an organization organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes in support of Valley High School and/or its programs as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed off by the State District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes, or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

ARTICLE X – PERSONAL LIABILITY

No member, officer, or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers, or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE XI – INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation may indemnify a person who was, is, or is threatened to be made a named defendant or respondent in litigation or other proceedings because the person is or was a director or other person related to the corporation as provided by the provisions of the Kentucky Uniform Unincorporated Nonprofit Act Governing Indemnification. As the bylaws provide, the Executive Board may define the requirements and limitations for the corporation to indemnify directors, officers or others related to the corporation.
