

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
JIMMY SMITH CONCRETE, LLC

The undersigned hereby forms and organizes a limited liability company pursuant to the Kentucky Limited Liability Company Act and adopts the following Articles of Organization of such limited liability company:

ARTICLE I

The name of this limited liability company is Jimmy Smith Concrete, LLC (hereinafter, the "Company"). The purpose of the Company shall be to engage in the business of construction services and all purposes related thereto and to engage in any other any lawful business for which a limited liability company may be organized under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

ARTICLE II

The effective date of these Articles of Organization shall be the date these Articles are filed with the Kentucky Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V

The Company shall be member-managed.

ARTICLE VI

The duration of the limited liability company shall be perpetual, except and until its dissolution in accordance with the Kentucky Limited Liability Company Act or the operating agreement of the Company.


ARTICLE VII

The name and mailing address of the Company's organizer is James D. Smith, 1470 US Highway 60 W, Ledbetter, Kentucky 42058.


