Pursuant to the provision of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, KRS 14A and KRS 275, the undersigned organizer(s) hereby adopts the following articles of organization for **SERIOUS PERFORMANCE LLC**.

1. The name of the limited liability company is **SERIOUS PERFORMANCE LLC**.
2. The street address and zip code of the original registered office of the LLC is 1119 Crestwood Ct, Flatwoods, KY 41139 and the name of its initial registered agent at that office is Ryan Gayheart.

4. The LLC will be **member-managed** in accordance with the provisions of the Kentucky Limited Liability Company Act, K.R.S. 275 et seq., and more specifically KRS 275-165.

7. No member, solely by reason of being a Member of the LLC, shall be an agent of the LLC. The member(s) shall enter into an Operating Agreement, and each member shall be bound by the Operating Agreement whether fully executed or not. The Operating Agreement shall specifically identify those actions that each Member can take on behalf of the LLC without the express written consent of all the other Members.

To the fullest permitted by applicable law and the LLC's Operating Agreement, no member, manager, employee, or agent of the LLC shall be personally liable by reason of being a member, manager, employee or agent of the LLC, under a judgment, decree, or order of a court, agency or tribunal of any type, or in any other manner in the state of Kentucky or any other state, or on any other basis, for a debt, obligation, or liability of the LLC, whether arising in contract, tort or otherwise. The status of a person as a member, manager, employee or agent of the LLC shall not subject the person to personal liability for the acts or omissions, including any negligence, wrongful act or actionable conduct, of any other member, manager, agent, or employee of the LLC.
9. This LLC shall have a perpetual duration.
10. This application will be effective upon filing.
