

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION**OF****VEIN CARE CENTER, PLLC**

The undersigned, Ziad William Sara for the purpose of forming a professional limited liability company under the Kentucky Limited Liability Company Act, Kentucky Revised Statutes Chapter 275 (the "Act"), hereby makes, acknowledges and files the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I**NAME**

The name of the professional limited liability company is "Vein Care Center, PLLC" (the "Company").

ARTICLE II**INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

The mailing address of the initial principal office of the Company in Kentucky shall be 3229 Summit Square Place, Suite 240, Lexington, Kentucky 40509

ARTICLE III**DURATION**

The Company shall commence its existence on the date these Articles of Organization are filed with the Kentucky Secretary of State. The Company's existence shall be perpetual, save and until its dissolution in accordance with the Act and the Company's Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE IV**PURPOSE AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED**

The general purpose for which the Company is organized is to conduct a medical practice under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Company shall have all the powers granted to a limited liability company under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

ARTICLE V
REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the Company's initial registered office in the Commonwealth of Kentucky is 2409 Rossini Place, Lexington, Kentucky 40509. The name of the initial registered agent of the Company at that office is Ziad William Sara.

ARTICLE VI
MANAGEMENT

The management of the Company is reserved to the Members, to be exercised in accordance with the Company's Operating Agreement. The Operating Agreement may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with law or these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE VII
STATEMENT OF LIMITED LIABILITY

Except as otherwise provided by Kentucky law, no member, manager, agent or employee of the Company shall be personally liable for the debts, obligations or liabilities of the Company, whether arising in contract, tort or otherwise, or for the acts or omissions of any other member, manager, agent or employee of the Company.
