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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

East Kentucky Fair, Inc.

ARTICLE I Name

This corporation shall be known as East Kentucky Fair, Inc. By this name, the corporation may contract, be contracted with, sue, be sued, adopt a corporate seal and conduct its business and operate as a nonprofit corporation pursuant to KRS 273.

ARTICLE II Membership

This corporation shall not have capital stock and shall be composed of members rather than shareholders.

ARTICLE III Purpose and Nature of the Corporation

East Kentucky Fair, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Specific purpose of the corporation shall be:

- A. To plan, develop, and organize an annual fair and other programs to stimulate public interest in the advantages and development of the Commonwealth by providing exhibitions, public gatherings, educational opportunities, cultural activities and other functions.
- B. To advance Kentucky's tourism industry and economy while serving the entertainment, cultural and educational interests of the public.
- C. To transact any and all other lawful business for which a corporation may be organized under KRS Chapter 273, and to do any and all acts, and to execute and perform any and all powers necessary, proper, incidental or convenient in carrying out the purposes set forth above, as fully as any natural person might do.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not engage in any transaction that is a prohibited transaction as defined in Section 501c(3) of the

Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent United State Revenue law.

ARTICLE IV Registered Office and Process Agent

The principal office and registered office of the corporation are one and the same, being 110 Resource Court, Prestonsburg, Kentucky 41653 and Mr. James Whited is located at this office and is the initial registered agent of the corporation for the service of process, and incorporation.

ARTICLE V Board of Directors

The business of the corporation shall be conducted and managed by the Board of Directors, the number and appointment of which shall be set out in the bylaws of the corporation. The number of directors constituting the initial Board upon incorporation shall be Twenty-Six (26). The names and addresses of the persons who are first serving as these directors are as follows:

ARTICLE VI Non-Profit Status

The corporation is not to be organized for profit nor shall it have the power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall benefit or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay a reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign, or on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted (a) by a corporation exempt form Federal Income Tax under Section 501 c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 c (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

ARTICLE VII Disposition of Assets

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the board shall make provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation and dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United State Internal Revenue Law) or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VIII Committees

The Board of Directors, by resolution adopted by a majority of the directors, may authorize the Chairperson to appoint one or more committees, each of which shall consist of at least two or more directors. A committee, to the extent provided in said resolution, shall have and exercise authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the corporation, as defined in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX Members Not Liable for Corporate Obligations

The members of the Board of Directors, the officers, and the staff of the corporation shall not be personally liable for corporate obligations, including but not limited to those arising from fiscal or personnel matters, pursuant to KRS 273.187.

ARTICLE X Amendment

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members of the Board of Directors at a regular or special meeting for which proper notice has been provided. The filing of such amendment shall comply with KRS 273.263.
