# ARTICLE V ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

## ARTICLE VIII NON-LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

A. A manager of this Company shall not be personally liable to the Company or its members for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a manager, except for liability (I) for any breach of the manager's duty or loyalty to the Company or its members, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or knowing violation of law, (iii) for a transaction from which the manager derived an improper personal benefit, or (iv) under K.R.S. § 275.150 of the Kentucky Limited Liability Company Act (or any similar provisions of any subsequent law enacted in Kentucky).

B. Each individual who is or was a manager of the Company (and the heirs, executors, personal representatives or administrators of such individual) who was or is made a part to, or is involved in any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, by reason of the fact that such person is or was a manager of the Company or is or was serving at the request of the Company as a manager, director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another limited liability company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benefit plan or other enterprise ("Indemnitee"), shall be indemnified and held harmless by the Company to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, as the same exists or may hereafter

be amended. In addition to the indemnification conferred in this Article, the Indemnitee shall also be entitled to have paid directly by the Company the expenses reasonably incurred in defending any such proceeding against such Indemnitee in advance of its final disposition, to the fullest extent authorized by applicable law, as the same exists or may hereafter be amended. The right to indemnification conferred in this Article shall be a contract right.

C. The Company may, by action of the managers, provide indemnification to such of the officers, employees and agents of the Company to such extent and to such effect as the managers shall determine to be appropriate and authorized by applicable law.

D. The rights and authority conferred in this Article shall not be exclusive of any other right which any person may have or hereafter acquire under any statute, provision of the Articles of Organization or Operating Agreement of the Company, agreement, vote of members or disinterested managers, or otherwise.

E. Any repeal or amendment of this Article by the members of the Company shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a manager or officer existing at the time of such repeal or amendment.
