Articles of Incorporation

1. Name

The name of the corporation (Church) is:

New Bethel Church, Inc.

2. Purpose

The Church is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, without limitation, the participation of the Church in any or all other lawful activities (including taxable activities) to the extent the activities are permissible for a church exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and to which contributions are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

More particularly, but without limitation, the purposes of the Church are:

- (a) To be an instrument of God to evangelize Salyersville, Kentucky and the World;
 - (b) To be a channel for God and to build a body of believers being complete in the image of Christ,
 - (c) To fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus Christ;
 - (d) To establish and operate a Church;
 - (e) To develop a vibrant praise and worship service to complement sound Biblical teaching;
 - (f) To reach out to our community through evangelism, community service and, special ministries;

- (g) To train new Christian leaders to meet the needs of the future;
- (h) To support local and foreign missions; and
- (i) To promote the Christian faith by any appropriate form of expression, within any available medium, and in any location, through the Church's combined or separate formation of a church, ministry, charity, school, or other organization.

5. Management

The management of the affairs of the Church is vested in the Board of Directors.

6. Members

The Church will not have members.

7. Autonomy

The Church is autonomous and maintains the right to govern its own affairs, independent of denominational control. Recognizing, however, the benefits of cooperation with other churches in fulfilling our purposes, the Church may voluntarily affiliate with other churches in any denomination, association, or convention of churches (Denomination).

If there is any conflict between a Denomination's governing documents (including, without limitation, articles, bylaws, or applications) and these Articles, then these Articles will control concerning the governance, control, and property of the Church. The only remedy a Denomination may have regarding the Church is disaffiliation.

8. Dissolution

If the Church dissolves, net assets must be distributed for exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or to the government (federal, state, or local) for a public purpose.

9. Construction

All references to legal authority refer to the authorities cited or their successors, as they may be amended from time to time.

10. Amendment

These Articles may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the Board of Directors.

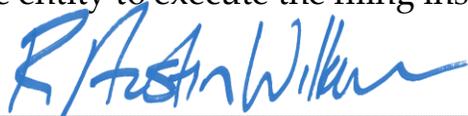
