ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF EDMONDS LAW, PLLC

The undersigned Organizer, Blaine J. Edmonds III, executes these Articles of Organization for the purpose of forming a Professional Limited Liability Company under Chapter 275 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky in accordance with the following provisions:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Limited Liability Company is EDMONDS LAW, PLLC.

ARTICLE II

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

This initial registered agent shall be Blaine J. Edmonds III. The street address of the initial registered office of the Limited Liability Company in the Commonwealth of Kentucky is 157 Barnwood Drive, Suite 205, Edgewood, Kentucky 41017.

ARTICLE III

INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The mailing address of the initial principal office of the Limited Liability Company is 157 Barnwood Drive, Suite 205, Edgewood, Kentucky 41017.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERS

The Limited Liability Company has at least two (2) members and they are: Blaine J. Edmonds III and Jennifer M. Edmonds.

ARTICLE V

PURPOSES AND POWERS

This Professional Limited Liability Company is formed for all lawful purposes and has the power to do all things necessary and convenient in transacting business and carrying on its business affairs, specifically including the practice of law.

ARTICLE VI

MANAGEMENT

The management of the Limited Liability Company shall be by its members

ARTICLE VII

PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of duration of the Limited Liability Company shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VIII

ARTICLE IX

INDEMNIFICATION

The Professional Limited Liability Company shall indemnify any person who is or was a party, or who is threatened to be made a party, to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, including all appeals, by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a member, managing member, or organizer of the Professional Limited Liability Company, or is or was serving at the request of the Professional Limited Liability Company as a director, trustee,

officer of employee of another limited liability company, corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against any and all expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees), judgments, decrees, fines, penalties and amounts paid in settlement, which were actually and reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with such action, suit of proceeding, if he or she acted in good faith and in a manner which he or she reasonably believed to be in, or at least not opposed to, the best interests of the Professional Limited Liability Company, and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, he or she had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful. The termination of any action, suit or proceeding by judgment, order, settlement, conviction or plea of nolo contendere or its equivalent shall not, of itself, create a presumption that the person did not act in good faith and in a manner which he or she reasonably to be in, or at least not opposed to, the best interests of the Professional Limited Liability Company.

The foregoing indemnification shall not apply in the case of an action, suit or proceeding instituted by one or more members of the Professional Limited Liability Company, if the claim, matter or issue raised therein is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to have resulted from the negligence or misconduct of the member(s) seeking indemnification; provided, however, that such indemnification shall nonetheless apply if, in view of all of the circumstances of the case, such court shall determine that such member(s) is/are fairly and reasonable entitled to indemnification, with respect to such expenses, judgments, decrees, fines, penalties and amounts paid in settlement as determined by the court.

Expenses of each person indemnified hereunder incurred in defending against a civil, criminal, administrative or investigative action, suit or proceeding (including all appeals,)

or threat thereof, may be paid by the Professional Limited Liability Company in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding, as authorized by a majority in interest of the members, upon receipt of an undertaking by such person to repay such amount unless it shall ultimately be determined that he or she is entitled to indemnified by the Professional Limited Liability Company.
