**General Information**

**The Purpose/ Nature of business**

The purposes for which the organization is organized and operated are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational with the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code, or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law. Such purposes shall include the following:

- No part of the Net Earning of the organization shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
- No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. And the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statement(s) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles.
- The Organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (A) by an Organization Exempt from Federal Income Tax Under Section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code, or The Corresponding section of any future federal Tax Code, or

(B) By an organization, Contributions to which are deductible under section 170(C)(2) the internal Revenue Code. Or the corresponding section of any future federal Tax Code

#### **Distribution of assets on dissolution of final liquidation**

The Organization is a non-profit organization that evolved from the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church. Therefore upon the dissolution of the organization, and resolution of all fiduciary obligation, all remaining assets will be liquidated to the national body of the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church, Incorporated. The management of its affairs is vested in its members pursuant to Kentucky Statues and the publication known as the Book of Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church (A.M.E.Z.C) as now published but which may hereafter be revised and published by the A.M.E.Z.C. acting through the supreme body. The General Conference of the A.M.E.Z.C. all property belongs to the African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church whenever, hereafter a particular congregation shall cease to function or exits, or become extinct by reason of the dispersal of its members, the abandonment of its work, or cause, such property as it may have whether real, personal, intellectual, tangible, or intangible shall be held in trust by the Hughlett Temple African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church Board of Trustees and used, and applied for such, purposes, and trusts as the Annual Conference, within whose bounds the local church situated, may directed, limit and appoint, or such property may be sold or disposed of in accordance with the provisions of the Book of Discipline, such as to settle outstanding debts, etc.
