#### ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

## Article II:

<u>Purpose</u>. The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for public, religious, literary, charitable, scientific, and/or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax law) (the "Code") and specifically including, without limitation the care of retired Connemara ponies and for making contributions in furtherance of such purposes.

Restrictions on Activities. The corporation is formed otherwise than for the pecuniary gain or profit of, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons; provided, that the corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes, and distribute its assets on dissolution in accordance with these articles. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation described in section 501(c)(3) and exempt from taxation under section 501(a) of the Code, or by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

<u>Dissolution</u>. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the directors shall wind up the affairs of the corporation as speedily as practicable and, after paying or adequately providing for the payment of all known obligations of the corporation, distribute the remainder of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or to organizations organized and operated exclusively for the purposes of the corporation described in Section 501(c)(3) and exempt from taxation under Section 501(a) of the Code in such manner as the directors shall determine. Any such assets not so distributed shall be applied as may be directed by a court of competent jurisdiction in an action brought in accordance with the Kentucky Revised Statutes exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
