

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION-SECOND CHANCE MINISTRIES

These Articles of Incorporation, made and entered into this 1st day of June 2014, evidence that Second Chance Ministries is a Nonprofit Organization pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statutes Chapter 273, including all other acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, as follows:

Article I

The name of this Nonprofit Organization shall be Second Chance Ministries (the "NPO").

Article II

The NPO's existence shall be perpetual unless dissolved in a manner provided for under applicable laws in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Article III

The purpose of the NPO is to help those who are starting their life over. Whether getting out of prison or immigrating to the United States of America, the NPO strives to aide those who desire a second chance at life. The NPO's mission is to teach and empower those experiencing their second chance to become employed, self-sustaining individuals.

Article IV

The NPO's initial registered office is 4008 Emerald Spring Place, Louisville, Kentucky 40245, which may be changed in a manner provided by law without amendment to these articles.

Article V



Article VI


