1. Name

If the Corporation dissolves, net assets must be distributed for exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or to the government (federal, state, or local) for a public purpose.

10. Construction

All references to legal authority refer to the authorities cited or their successors, as they may be amended from time to time.

11. Amendment

These Articles may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the Board of Directors.
