**WRIT OF ELECTION**


**Nineteenth District – Kentucky Senate**


**WHEREAS**, due to the resignation of the Honorable Morgan McGarvey, Senator from the Nineteenth District of the Kentucky Senate, effective at the close of business on January 2, 2023, a vacancy exists in the Kentucky Senate, Nineteenth District; and

**WHEREAS**, KRS 118.730 requires the Governor to issue a writ of election to fill a vacancy occurring in the Kentucky Senate when the General Assembly is not in session; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly will be in session beginning January 3, 2023 through March 30, 2023, and the people of Jefferson County as described in KRS 5.119 should be represented without any undue delay;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Andy Beshear**, by virtue of the authority vested in me by KRS 118.730, do hereby issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy in the Kentucky Senate, Nineteenth District, to be held on February 21, 2023, and hereby direct that this writ be forwarded to the Sheriff of Jefferson County, as required by KRS 118.730 and 118.740.
