STATE OF EMERGENCY

Beginning on March 14, 2024, and continuing, a severe weather system containing heavy rain, large hail, continuous cloud-to-ground lightning, tornadoes, and intense damaging winds impacted the Commonwealth, creating dangerous conditions, including flash flooding, landslides, tornadic impacts to structures, and mudslides which caused damage to public infrastructure, utility distribution systems, and private properties;

These conditions endanger public health and safety and/or public and private property;

State and local governments share responsibility for protection of public health, safety, and security as well as for the protection of public and private property and for taking appropriate actions to ensure the provision of essential public services;

On March 14, 2024, I declared by Executive Order 2024-241 that a State of Emergency existed in the Commonwealth of Kentucky;

Under KRS 39A.090(2)(b), the state of emergency declared under Executive Order 2022-241 may exceed 30 days if requested by a chief executive officer or a legislative body of a local government only for that local government and only for the period of time requested by the chief executive officer or legislative body;

On April 12, 2024, the Trimble County Judge/Executive submitted the attached written request that the State of Emergency be extended for Trimble County, Kentucky, for 30 days;

The State of Emergency continues;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Andy Beshear, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution of Kentucky and by KRS Chapter 39A and KRS 151.200, do hereby declare that a State of Emergency continues to exist in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and do hereby Order and Direct that Executive Order 2024-241 be extended through May 13, 2024 in the following local jurisdictions:

Trimble County, Kentucky.



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This order is effective April 14, 2024.
