EXECUTIVE ORDER

State government has the responsibility to provide for public health, safety, and welfare; and

The Secretary of the Justice and Public Safety Cabinet has requested support from the Department of Military Affairs in the conduct of the Cabinet's legal and constitutional duties; and

It is appropriate and desirable to combine the resources of the Kentucky National Guard in joint operation with other state agencies; and

The Kentucky National Guard has special personnel and equipment resources to assist state and local authorities in protection of life, public health, and safety, to promote the public welfare, to prevent undue loss and suffering, and to mitigate the effects of such events;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Andy Beshear, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by virtue of the authority vested in me by KRS 38.030 and KRS 39A.950, do hereby authorize the issuance of appropriate State Active Duty Orders for the necessary officers, troops, and equipment required in order to provide an immediate response to the request for support and assistance as set forth above, to include the required administrative expense and further subsequently authorized expenses, from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.



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This Order is effective July 1, 2024.
