To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come:

- WHEREAS, Natural gas workers construct, operate, and maintain a network of natural gas infrastructure assets that provide communities across the Commonwealth with warm homes and businesses and cleaner electricity; and
- WHEREAS, It is important for Kentucky to honor and recognize these workers for their contributions to the lives of Kentuckians and the success of our state's economy; and
- WHEREAS, At a moment's notice, these brave crews work in all weather systems and face dangerous conditions in order to maintain the energy infrastructure of our state; and
- WHEREAS, The provision of natural gas is an essential service, and these crews work tirelessly in times of natural disasters, ensuring communities have safe and reliable natural gas service; and
- WHEREAS, Working in and around roadways is often required of crews who provide natural gas service, potentially putting them in danger; and
- WHEREAS, Safety is a vital aspect to natural gas transmission and distribution, and the employees of such companies endeavor to make natural gas delivery as safe as possible; and
- WHEREAS, March 18 is a national day of recognition known as National Natural Gas Workers' Day as a way of building awareness about the hard work done by employees of natural gas utilities;
