

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF ADAIRVILLE, KENTUCKY.

The City Council of the City of Adairville, Logan
County, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, this City Council did on the 13th day of
March, 1972, enact an ordinance entitled ORDINANCE PROPOSING
TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ADAIRVILLE, KEN-
TUCKY; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance was thereafter published
pursuant to KRS Chapter 424; and

WHEREAS, no protest pursuant to the provisions
of KRS Chapter 81 to this annexation was made;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of
Adairville, Logan County, Kentucky, does ordain that the
following specifically described property as shown by plat
attached hereto and made a part hereof, be, and same hereby is
annexed to the City of Adairville, Logan County, Kentucky:

Beginning at an iron pin, said iron pin
being the point of intersection of the
south margin of Burr Alley and the East
boundary line of the City of Adairville;
said beginning point is also in the north
boundary line of F. L. Price's property;
thence with F. L. Price's north boundary
line and with a fence North 88°00' East
127.1 feet to an iron pin, the northeast
corner of the herein described tract;
thence South 2°00' East 718.2 feet to an
iron pin; thence South 10°47' West 214.4
feet to an iron spike in the center line
of East Gallatin Street, being the south-
east corner of the herein described tract;
thence westerly, around a curve to the left
having a radius of 374.28 feet and with the
center line of East Gallatin Street, 68.64
feet to an iron spike, the southwest corner
of the herein described tract, said spike
being 1,076 feet east of the center line
of Main Street; then leaving the center
line of East Gallatin Street and running
with the present east boundary line of the
city limits of the City of Adairville, North
3°31' West 907.8 feet to the point of begin-
ning and containing 2.53 acres.
