RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ADAIRVILLE, KENTUC ADOPTING THE ORDINANCE APPROVED JULY 14, 1980 (Control of ANNEXING 10,276 ACRES INTO THE CITY OF ADAIRVILLE

WHEREAS, on July 14, 1980, the City of Adairville, Kentucky, passed an unnumbered Ordinance annexing certain territory into the City of Adairville, Kentucky, which was conveyed by Guy E. Orndorff, unmarried, to the City of Adairville, by DEED dated November 12, 1979, recorded in Deed Book 232, Page 427, in the Office of the Logan County Court Clerk, and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance and annexation was by consent of the sole owner of the property, the City of Adairville, and did not require publication, and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance annexing that property into the City of Adairville, Kentucky, was adopted by roll call vote, duly signed by the Mayor, John Sweatt, and duly attested by the City Clerk, Dolores E. Stratton, and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 1981, the Mayor, for the City of Adairville, Kentucky, John Sweatt, in compliance with KRS 81.045 submitted to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Secretary of State a city map he certified contained the proper boundaries for the City of Adairville, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the map certified by the Mayor on April 24, 1981, through neglect or inadvertence did not include the annexed property passed by Ordinance dated July 14, 1980,

WHEREAS, the plat and legal description contained in the Ordinance dated July 14, 1980, do not now comply with the requirements of KRS 81.A070, and

WHEREAS the new survey and plat prepared by DDI Engineering under the direction of Frank J. Kondracki, Jr., in October, 2012, is a boundary retracement of the

original property annexed by the Ordinance passed on July 14, 1980, which complies with KRS 81.A070,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Adairville, Kentucky, adopts the Ordinance of Annexation passed July 14, 1980,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the property annexed by the Ordinance passed July 14, 1980, is shown on the attached plat and more particularly described as follows:

Being a certain parcel of land located behind Adairville Elementary School at the Community Park for the City of Adairville, Logan County, Kentucky, and being further described as follows:

Unless stated otherwise, any monument referred to as an iron pin and cap is a 5/8-inch by 18-inch rebar with an aluminum cap stamped "LS2474." All bearings contained herein are referenced to Kentucky State Plane Coordinates (SPC83 South).

Beginning at a 5/8" rebar and no cap (found) (1765880.88-N, 1315903.80-E) in the original city limits line of Adairville, Kentucky, and being in the line of Don Halcomb (Deed Book 385, Page 655) same also being the southwest corner of the City of Adairville's 10.24 acre property purchased from Guy E.Orndorff (Deed Book 232, Page 427) same located South 56° 18' 06" West 820.51 feet from the northwest corner of Adairville Elementary School building; thence from said beginning and along the original city limits line, North 51° 55' 03" East 1203.63 feet to to an iron pin and cap (found), marked PLS #3290 (1766623.28-N, 1316851.20-E) corner to Halcomb (Deed Book 385, Page 655); thence with Halcomb and the 1980 city limits line of Adairville the following three (3) calls: North 33° 15' 03" West 399.87 feet to a 5/8" rebar and cap (found) PLS #3290 (1766957.68-N, 1316631.95-E); South 50° 51' 55" West 1106.36 feet to a 5/8" rebar and cap (found) PLS #3290 (1766259.40-N, 1315773.79-E); and, South 18° 57' 22" East 400.23 feet to the Point of Beginning; containing 447,603 sq. ft. or 10.276 acres more or less, according to a boundary retracement field survey conducted by DDI Engineering under the direction of Frank J. Kondracki, Jr., "PLS2474," during the month of October, 2012.

Being the same property conveyed by Guy E. Orndorff, unmarried, to the City of Adairville, by DEED dated November 12, 1979, recorded in Deed Book 232, Page 427, in the Office of the Logan County Court Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Adairville adopts this legal description as the same property annexed by the City of Adairville by the Ordinance passed on July 14, 1980,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Ordinance was by consent of the sole owner of the property, the City of Adairville, and did not require publication, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Ordinance was omitted and the area was not described in the KRS 81.045 filing submitted to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Secretary of State by Mayor John Sweatt on April 24, 1981, through neglect or inadvertence;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Adairville, Kentucky, on roll call vote directed a certified copy of this RESOLUTION and a certified copy of the original Ordinance be sent to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Secretary of State so that the filing for KRS 81.045 may be corrected to include the property described above annexed into the City of Adairville, Kentucky, on July 14, 1980.
