

## ORDINANCE 5 -91



AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY THE REMAINDER OF THE NEISER/GOSNEY FARM, A 26.66-ACRE TRACT OF LAND BOUNDING ON AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE EAST CORPORATION LINE OF THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on January 8, 1991 the City of Alexandria, Kentucky adopted Ordinance 1-91 declaring its intent to annex a certain parcel of unincorporated territory consisting of the balance of the Neiser/Gosney Farm which had not been previously annexed into the City;

WHEREAS, the City has elected to establish zoning for the territory prior to final action upon the Ordinance of Annexation, which was done by adoption of Ordinance 4 -91; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the real estate have indicated their desire to be annexed to the City of Alexandria, Kentucky and have, pursuant to KRS 81A.412, signed a consent in writing to the annexation, thus waiving the 60-day period provided for in KRS 81A.420(2) prior to enacting a final Ordinance annexing the area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Alexandria, Campbell County, Kentucky hereby annexes to the City a parcel of unincorporated territory as described in Section 2 hereof. Said territory shall, upon the passage of this Ordinance, become part of the City for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The unincorporated territory annexed is described as follows:

Being situated in Campbell County Kentucky, lying along the north side of Poplar Ridge Road at Peggy Ann Lane, being adjacent to the current limits of the City of Alexandria, and being more particularly described:

Beginning at the original northwest corner of the Neiser Property in the line of Hatcher and common corner to Allender, Thence N 74°-10'-36" E 594.73' to an iron pin in the south right of way for State Rt. 546; Thence along right of way for Poplar Ridge Road N 63°-39'-46" E 227.83' to an iron pin; Thence S 37°-44'-36" E 227.22' to a concrete monument; Thence S 52°-31'-03" E 235.07' to a concrete monument; Thence S 38°-46'-19" E 451.37' to a concrete monument; Thence S 56°-34'-37" E 205.88' to a concrete monument; 25°-28'-28" E 133.94' to a concrete monument; Thence S 31°-05'-40" E 120.87 more or less to the existing corporate limits of the City Alexandria; Thence along the City Limits 85°-11-52" W 1239.05' to the west line of the Property; Thence along Allender 22°-44'-14" W 1107.03' more or less to the point of beginning. Containing 26.668 Acres of Land.

SECTION 3.

A map is attached hereto and

incorporated herein by reference designating the newly annexed area and showing the zoning which will be effective for the annexed property.

SECTION 4. A certified copy of this Ordinance, together with the map of the annexed area, along with a list of the names and addresses of those property owners and/or registered voters who reside in such area shall be delivered to the Campbell County Clerk.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, if any, hereby repealed.

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SECTION 6. An emergency exists in the City of Alexandria, Kentucky inasmuch as the sale and development of this property has been delayed, and to avoid further postponement of the sale closing of the subject property, to avoid further delays in the construction and development of the property, the necessity for two readings is hereby suspended and an emergency declared, whereupon this Ordinance shall become effective upon an affirmative vote of 2/3 of Council and publication according to law.

SECTION 7. The foregoing Ordinance was

read, passed and adopted by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Kentucky meeting in regular session on the 24th day of January, 1991.
