ORDER TO DISSOLVE CITY OF ALLENSVILLE, KENTUCKY

The Petitioners, Eric Campbell, Mark Majors and Larry Head, by counsel, petitioned the Court pursuant to KRS 81.096 for dissolution of the City of Allensville, Kentucky, the Court having entered an Order for Intervenors which was duly advertised; no one having filed a petition to intervene, the Court Should and Hereby does find as follows:

- 1. The Petitioners are bona fide residents of the City of Allensville, Kentucky;
- 2. The City of Allensville, Kentucky previously functioned as a city as defined by the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky;
- 3. The City of Allensville, Kentucky, has failed to, for more than one (1) year, maintain a city government by either the election or appointment of officers and levying and collection of necessary taxes; specifically, no city officers have been elected in over thirty (30) years; nor any taxes levied or collected.
- 4. The City of Allensville is more particularly described in Exhibit "A" to the Petitioner's position.

As a result of the failure of the City of Allensville, Kentucky to function, as herein set forth, and further, due to impracticability, given the size and population of the City of Allensville to function as a city, the City of Allensville, Kentucky, Should Be, and Is Hereby Dissolved.

This is a Final Judgment and there is no just reason for delay.
