## **ORDINANCE NO.** \_\_\_\_3, 1996

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, KENTUCKY, ANNEXING THE HAMPTON HILLS SUBDIVISION.

\* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \*

WHEREAS, the City of Ashland, Kentucky, has been requested by John Wolhoy to annex his subdivision known as Hampton Hills;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ASHLAND, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. The Board of Commissioners of the City of Ashland hereby annexes that certain territory within Boyd County adjoining the present boundary line of the City, being Hampton Hills Subdivision. The description and map of the territory are attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference as if set out in full. The specific description appears on Exhibit "A". The map is marked Exhibit "B" for identification.

SECTION 2. The Board of Commissioners has determined that this territory is desirable for annexation. The territory is adjacent or contiguous to the City's boundaries and is urban in character.

SECTION 3. Upon the enactment of the Ordinance, the territory shall become a part of the City for all purposes.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict only, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, readoption and publication, as required by haw



## EXHIBIT A

Beginning at a point in the City of Ashland Corporation line on the easterly side of Roberts Drive, said point being S 35 degrees, 08 minutes, 00 seconds W 5 feet plus or minus and S 31 degrees, 13 minutes, 08 seconds W 57.07 feet from the intersection of the center line of Blevins Street and the Corporation Limit line; thence across Roberts Drive, the CSX Railroad and Hardeman Drive and with the line of Hampton Hills Subdivision, N 84 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds W 249.13 feet to an iron pin; thence N 83 degrees, 56 minutes, 14 seconds W 83.87 feet; thence N 84 degrees, 12 minutes, 04 seconds W 26.13 feet to an iron pin; thence N 84 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds W 215.00 feet to a concrete monument; thence N 5 degrees, 59 minutes, 58 seconds E 442.28 feet to an iron pin; thence S 84 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds E 765.81 feet crossing Hardeman Drive, the CSX Railroad and Roberts Drive to a point in the City of Ashland Corporation line on the easterly side of Roberts Drive, thence with the edge of Roberts Drive, S 24 degrees, 02 minutes, 00 seconds W 225.00 feet; thence S 30 degrees. 42 minutes, 00 seconds W 96.00 feet; thence S 35 degrees, 08 minutes, 00 seconds W 106.00 feet; thence S 31 degrees, 13 minutes, 08 seconds W 57.07 feet to the point of beginning.
