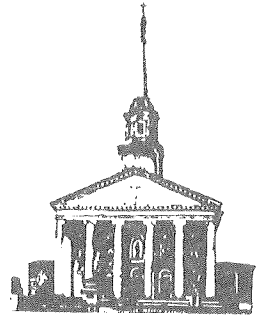



ORDINANCE NO. 433

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND IN NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, BEING IN THE NORTH LIMITS OF THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINES OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has expressed its desire and intent to annex certain unincorporated territory located in Nelson County, Kentucky, herein called the "Annexation Area" to the City; and

WHEREAS, the owners, in fee simple, through a written document, have pursuant to KRS 81A.500, requested annexation by the City of the unincorporated "Annexation Area", which is more fully described below;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY:

The present boundaries of the City of Bardstown, Kentucky, are hereby extended to include within said City a certain tract of land located in the north limits of the City of Bardstown, the boundaries of which is defined and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the existing City boundary line approximately 1250 feet north of KY 245 and 2000 feet west of US 62 East in the division line of the City of Bardstown and CNW, Inc., and proceeding along the existing City Boundary line S 67 degrees 48 minutes East 1901.11 feet to a point in the western side line of lot 1-A1 of the Stephen Foster Industrial Park Phase I as shown in Plat Cabinet 1 slots 378 and 391, in the office of the Nelson County Clerk; thence following the division line between CNW, Inc., and the Stephen Foster Industrial Park Phase I North 12 degrees 51 minutes East 1569.73 feet to a point at the intersection of Phase I and Phase II of the Stephen Foster Industrial Park; thence continuing with CNW, Inc., and Phase II, North 12 degrees 51 minutes East 1070.17 feet to the intersection of CNW, Inc., and the northwestern most point of the Stephen Foster Industrial Park Phase II; thence striking a new City boundary line with the line of CNW Inc. and John Mayer North 12 degrees 51 minutes East 2107.10 feet to the Northeast corner of CNW, Inc.; thence North 67 degrees 15 minutes west 1551 feet to the Northwest corner of CNW Inc. at a point, corner to John Mudd and John Douglas Hubbard; thence continuing with the property line of CNW, Inc., South 13 degrees 45 minutes West 1188.0 feet to a point; thence South 18 degrees 30 minutes West 411 feet to the corner of Drake; thence with Drake South 19 degrees 08 minutes East 543.79 feet to the corner with Langan; thence with Langan South 23 degrees 26 minutes West 357.98 feet to the corner with Clark; thence with Clark South 50 degrees 47 minutes west 564.01 feet to the corner with the City of Bardstown; thence with the City of Bardstown South 18 degrees 30 minutes West 1794 feet to the point of the beginning containing approximately 175 acres.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.
