## **RESOLUTION/MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 2010-09**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MODERN AND ACCURATE LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY PREVIOUSLY ANNEXED BY ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bardstown has enacted numerous ordinances annexing property into the corporate limits of the City of Bardstown; and

WHEREAS, each individual annexation contains a prior survey oft prepared by now unknown individual, and further references documentation that is no longer in existence; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide a modern, accurate, easily identifiable legal description reflecting bearings and coordinates based upon the state plane coordinate system, including relevant GPS and GIS data, same having been certified by a professional land surveyor for each prior annexation; and

WHEREAS, The City wishes to comply with the requirements of Amended KRS 81A.470 effective July 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the City does not intend to amend or replace its prior ordinance annexing, but rather to interpret the defined boundaries of the territory previously annexed and adopt a modern and accurate legal description of territory previously annexed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Bardstown hereby adopts the following legal description and a plat attached hereto as prepared by Stephen Hibbs, Licensed Professional Land Surveyor No. <u>2981</u> by new survey as an accurate depiction of the property previously annexed into the corporate city limits of the City of Bardstown by Ordinance <u>433</u>, dated <u>6/6/1990</u>, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "2", and hereby adopts said new legal description and plat as the official legal description and plat to be adopted by the City for all purposes when referencing this prior annexation.

SECTION 2. This new legal description as prepared by Stephen Hibbs a Licensed Professional Land Surveyor No. 2981 is as follows:

Beginning at a point, in the existing City Limit Line, approximately 1250 ft. north of Ky Hwy 245 and 2000 ft. west of U.S. Hwy 62, in the line of the City of Bardstown; thence with the City of Bardstown N 23-01-21 E 1604.49 ft. to a point, corner to the City of Bardstown and Bourbon Downs Subdivision; thence with said Subdivision N 54-43-30 E 564.37 ft.; N 27-01-31 E 357.97 ft.; N 15-22-24 W 544.16 ft.; N 19-28-39 E 601.55 ft.; N 17-10-26 E 1190.03 ft. to a point corner to Bourbon Downs Subd.; thence with Bourbon Downs Subd. S 66-40-24 E 540.45 ft.; S 66-10-51 E 196.38 ft.; S 64-12-34 E 539.35 ft. to a point, corner to Bourbon Downs Subd. and Tebco Inc.; thence with Tebco Inc. S 16-31-59 W 826.18 ft.; S 16-21-40 W 1217.22 ft.; S 17-00-43 W 1285.85 ft.; S 16-58-20 W 875.88 ft.; S 17-04-32 W 549.17 ft. to a point on the north side of U.S. Hwy 62, the original corner between Stephen Foster Industrial Park and Old Kentucky Home Industrial Park; thence with Old Kentucky Home Industrial Park N 61-24-30 W 950.21 ft.; N 65-58-36 W 962.92 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 175.02 acres.
