AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND IN NELSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, BEING IN THE NORTHWEST LIMITS OF THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINES OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, the City Council has expressed its desire and intent to annex certain unincorporated territory located in Nelson County, Kentucky, herein called the "Annexation Area" to the City; and

WHEREAS, the owners, in fee simple, through a written document, have pursuant to KRS 81A.500, requested annexation by the City of the unincorporated "Annexation Area", which is more fully described below;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY:

The present boundaries of the City of Bardstown, Kentucky, are hereby extended to include within said City a certain tract of land located in the north limits of the City of Bardstown, the boundaries of which is defined and described as follows:

A tract of land located on the western side of the City of Bardstown along KY Highway 1430 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the existing City limit line in the south line of KY 1430 in the property line of Houck, said point being across street from southwesternmost corner of Westview Subdivision (Hurst); thence continuing with the south line of KY 1430 and the existing city limit line N 20 W 483.5 feet; thence N 27 W 286.5 feet; thence N 33-26 W 69.3 feet; thence N 35-35 W 96.33 feet; thence N 40-41 W 99.58 feet; thence N 45-08 W 99.9 feet; thence N 48-44 W 100.25 feet; thence N 52-25 W 100.02 feet; thence N 60-04 W 96.4 feet; thence N 59-04 W 193 feet to a point in the existing city limit line and the south line of KY Highway 245 opposite from the southwesternmost corner of Greer (et. al.) thence striking a new city limit line across the street N 39-30 E 60 feet to a point in north line of KY Highway 245 and corner to Lewis and Greer (et. al.); thence with division line between Lewis and I.E. Greer (et. al.) line N 51-04-57 E 139.49 feet; thence N 19-28-47 W 100.19 feet to corner with Monin; thence running between Greer and Monin N 69-32-33 E 743.00 feet to existing city limit line, thence continuing with city limit line and between John Rowan Light Industrial Park and Greer S 37-36-27 E 1024.41 feet; thence S 12-15-10 E to City of Bardstown water tank site; thence running between City of Bardstown and John Rowan Light Industrial Park S 12-15-10 E 120 feet to point in westernmost line of Westview Subdivision; thence running between Westview Subdivision and City of Bardstown S 78-12-08 W 120 feet; thence continuing with westernmost line of Westview Subdivision and Greer S 78-32-20 W 335.74 feet; thence S 02-26-57 E 11.33 feet; thence S 78-21-28 W 342.77 feet to a point in the north line of KY 1430; thence continuing with

existing city limit line crossing KY 1430 S 68 W approximately 60 feet to the point of the beginning, containing approximately 34.8 acres.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
