

GREENUP CIRCUIT COURT.

IN THE MATTER OF:

Petition for the Incorporation of
the City of Bellefonte, Greenup
County, Kentucky.

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J U D G M E N T .

This day came the petitioners, by counsel, and filed herein the affidavit of E. D. Mittendorf, showing that notice of the filing of the petition herein, and of its object, has been published in the issues of June 16, 1951 and June 22, 1951, of the Russell Times, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Greenup.

And it appearing that the petition herein is signed by more than two-thirds of the voters living within the boundary of the proposed city; that said petition was filed more than twenty days before the commencement of the present term of this court; that more than 125 inhabitants reside within the boundaries of the proposed city; that said boundary of the proposed city does not extend more than one-half mile in each direction, and that the form thereof is square; that publication of notice of the filing of the petition, and of its object, has been made as required by law, and that no defense has been interposed herein, and the Court being advised, it is now

CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following described territory be and is hereby established as a city of the

sixth class, with all the powers and authority authorized by the Constitution and statutes of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and to be known as the City of Bellefonte:

Beginning at a concrete monument in the easterly line of the Bellefonte Country Club and at the southwest corner of the property of Dr. J. P. Scott; thence N. 33° 16' W. 1397.35 feet through the Country Club property, 243.42 feet westerly from and parallel to the westerly line of Country Club Drive; thence N. 17° 54' W. 1420.00 feet through Country Club and Dr. R. G. Culley property, 300.00 feet westerly from and parallel to the westerly line of Country Club Drive; thence N. 52° 06' E. 1565.00 feet, 300.00 feet northerly from and parallel to the northerly line of Clinton Drive; thence S. 57° 55' E. 300.00 feet; N. 52° 05' E. 35.00 feet; S. 55° 25' E. 280.00 feet; S. 43° 55' E. 420.00 feet; S. 30° E. 440.00 feet; S. 10° 03' W. 90.00 feet to a concrete monument at the northwest corner of lot No. 9, Block 23 of the Bellefonte Subdivision; thence with the west line of lot No. 9, Block 23, S. 10° 03' W. 710.03 feet to a concrete monument in the south line of Beuna Vista Drive, at the northwest corner of lot No. 26, Block No. 1 of Bellefonte Subdivision; thence with the southerly line of Beuna Vista Drive S. 79° 57' E. 178.14 feet; thence on the arc of a curve having a radius of 597.97 feet a distance of 170.45 feet; thence S. 74° 49' E. 15.31 feet; thence on the arc of a curve having a radius of 453.09 feet a distance of 285.06 feet; thence S. 69° 08' E. 84.36 feet; thence on the arc of a curve having a radius of 714.38 feet, a distance of 482.10 feet; thence S. 30° 28' E. 31.04 feet; thence on the arc of a curve having a radius of 50.00 feet, a distance of 78.54 feet to a concrete monument in the westerly line of Bellefonte-Princess Road (State Route No. 5); thence with the westerly line of Bellefonte-Princess Road S. 59° 32' W. 515.84 feet; thence on the arc of a curve having a radius of 429.26 feet, a distance of 119.37 feet; thence S. 43° 36' W. 260.98 feet; thence on the arc of a curve having a radius of 389.65 feet, a distance of 174.44 feet; thence S. 17° 57' W. 549.83 feet; S. 23° 42' W. 99.91 feet; S. 17° 55' W. 128.73 feet to a concrete monument in the west line of said Bellefonte-Princess Road and at the southeast corner of Lot No. 1, Block No. 19, of Bellefonte Subdivision; thence with the rear line of lots in Block 19, N. 82° 28' W. 794.14 feet; N. 53° 27' W. 217.09 feet to the beginning .

It is further ordered that George H. Todd, John C. Vigor, Elizabeth P. Beddoe, Fred M. Gross, and Davis E. Geiger, be and they are hereby appointed as Trustees of said City of Bellefonte, to hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities may be elected, and until their successors are qualified.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of this Court be, and he is hereby directed to certify forthwith a copy of this judgment to the Secretary of State, Frankfort, Kentucky, who shall

properly index and file the same as a permanent record in his office.
