ORDINANCE NO. 3 - 94

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEREAS, KENTUCKY, ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ON MENELAUS ROAD, BEREAS, MADISON COUNTY KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, interest has been evidenced in annexing a tract of land lying on or about Menelaus Road, Berea, Madison County, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the corporate boundaries of the City should be extended to include this area; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to be able to be in the position to extend certain municipal services to this area; and

WHEREAS, the tract described herein is not already incorporated; and

WHEREAS, the owners of the property agree to the annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of Berea, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I

The City of Berea, Kentucky, pursuant to KRS 81A.420 and KRS 81A.412, hereby annexes and makes a part of the corporate area of the City, the tract of property described as follows:

SECTION II

Upon the enactment of this ordinance, the territory described in Exhibit A is part of the City of Berea for all purposes.

SECTION III

The City Clerk or any other officer having custody of official maps or records of the City is hereby directed to amend such maps or records to reflect the annexation provided for herein.

SECTION IV

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
