A RESOLUTION APPOINTING JAMES HOUSE TO FILL THE VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF THE SAFETY COMMISSIONER ON THE BERRY CITY COMMISSION CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF DONALD BROWN, FOR THE REMAINDER OF HIS TERM, ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2010.

Be it resolved by the City of Berry:


Section 1. That Donald Brown, the elected City of Berry Safety Commissioner, has resigned thus creating a vacancy in the position of Safety Commissioner on the Berry City Commission.

Section 2. That pursuant KRS 83A.040(5) the remaining members of the Commission hereby appoint James House to the office of Safety Commissioner, for the remainder of the term of Donald Brown, ending December 31, 2010.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage as required by law.



OATH OF OFFICE


I, James House, Jr., do solemnly swear that I will support the Constitution of this Commonwealth, and the Constitution of the United States, and be faithful and true to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, so long as I continue a citizen thereof, and that I will faithfully execute, to the best of my ability, the Office of Commissioner of Public Safety of the City of Berry, according to law; and I do further solemnly swear that, since the adoption of the present Constitution, I being a citizen of this United States, have not fought a duel with deadly weapons within this State, nor out of it, nor have I sent or accepted a challenge to fight a duel with deadly weapons, nor have I acted as a second in so carrying a challenge, or aided or assisted any person thus offending, so help me God.
