I am in receipt of your letter of February 10, 1992, concerning the City of Blandville's Uniform Financial Information Report.

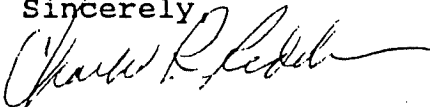
Please be advised that as of December 31, 1991, all of the terms of the City Council members and the Mayor of the City of Blandville expired. Since that date, Blandville has had no city government.

I have turned over all the Municipal Road Aid money we received to the Ballard County Fiscal Court for them to use on Blandville streets and have notified officials in the Department of Local Government that we are no longer operating as a city. The only funds that we had were those funds we received from the Municipal Road Aid program; and, consequently, we did not have an audit or financial report done.

Please remove the City of Blandville from the Municipal Road Aid list since there is no local city government in operation. I am returning the latest check I received as per instructions from Mr. Junie Tutterow.

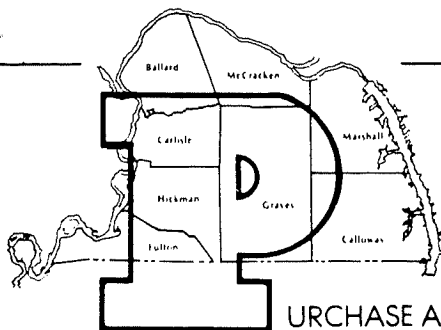
