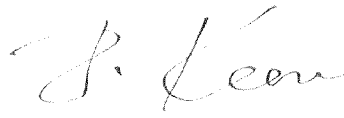
**FINAL ORDER OF COMMISSIONER, DEPARTMENT

The Commissioner of the Department for Local Government, having considered the entire record in this matter, including the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and the Recommended Order of the Administrative Hearing Officer dated August 7, 2023, and with there being no responses thereto filed, and being otherwise duly advised:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order of the Hearing Officer be hereby approved, ratified and incorporated herein as part of this decision. The Commissioner of the Department for Local Government approves and adopts the findings and recommendations of the Hearing Officer as his own.

The City of Blandville, Kentucky did not meet the requirements of KRS 81.062, and, therefore, shall be administratively dissolved.

APPEAL RIGHTS

All final orders of an agency shall be subject to judicial review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 13B.140. A party shall institute an appeal by filing a petition in the Circuit Court of venue, as provided in the agency's enabling statutes, within thirty (30) days after the final order of the agency is mailed or delivered by personal service. If venue for appeal is not stated in the enabling statutes, a party may appeal to Franklin Circuit Court or the Circuit Court of the county in which the appealing party resides or operates a place of business. Copies of the petition shall be served by the petitioner upon the agency and all parties of record. The petition shall include the names and addresses of all parties to the proceeding and the agency involved, and a statement of the grounds on which the review is requested. The petition shall be accompanied by a copy of the final order.
