ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY BY CONSENT COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE ANNEXING PORTIONS OF LOTS 5 AND 7 OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT CHERRY **PROPERTY** SUBDIVISION, WITH **FARMS** PRESENTLY OWNED BY CHERRY PARK, LLC, AND SAID TERRITORY BEING CONTIGUOUS TO EXISTING CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 81A.412, the City of Bowling Green may annex any area which meets the requirements for annexation if the owner of record of the land to be annexed gives prior consent in writing; and,

WHEREAS, Cherry Park, LLC, through its attorney, has requested and consented in writing to the annexation of portions of Lots 5 and 7 of property belonging to it located at Cherry Farms Subdivision, which is further identified on the attached map; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green hereby declares it desirable to annex this property as described in the attachments to this Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed property to be annexed is adjacent or contiguous to the City, and the property is urban in character and suitable for development for urban purposes without unreasonable delay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky pursuant to KRS 81A.412 as follows:

The property located at Cherry Farms Subdivision identified on the attached map and 1. further described in the attachment to this Ordinance containing portions of Lots 5 and 7, which is contiguous to existing City limits and presently owned by Cherry Park, LLC shall be and is hereby annexed into the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky by consent of the owners, and the boundaries of the City are hereby extended so as to include and incorporate all of this real estate into the City of Bowling CHE CLERK, THYLING SHEET, AGE

(Ordinance No. BG2009 - 23)

2. A copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the Public Works Department, Engineering

Division and it is hereby authorized and directed to make the necessary changes to the territorial limits

of the City in Chapter One of the City of Bowling Green Code of Ordinances to reflect this annexation.

3. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section,

phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not

affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

4. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in

conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

5. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to KRS 83A.060 in that it was introduced on

July 7 , 2009, and given final reading on July 31 , 2009,

and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon signature, recordation and publication in

Legal Description Cherry Farms Annexation

A portion of land lying in Warren County, Kentucky. Said parcel being located in the area of Bowling Green between Cumberland Trace, Old Scottsville Road and Scottsville Road. Said land being a portion of Lot 5 and Lot 7 of the Cherry Farms Subdivision recorded in Plat Book 37 Page 61, and being more particularly described as follows:

The basis of the bearings for this legal description is based on grid north as established by Kentucky State Plane Coordinates (KY South Zone 1602).

Beginning at a point in the line of Lot 7 of the Cherry Farms Subdivision (Plat Book 37 Page 61) and Lot 5 of the Deer Meadow Subdivision (Plat Book 25 Page 155), said point lying S 69°02'51" E a distance of 43.26' from the southwestern most corner of Lot 5. Thence, with the lines of Lot 7 and Lot 5, S 69°02'51" E a distance of 265.21' to a ½" iron pin with 1" cap found stamped "J Arnold PLS 2934" in the r/w of Deer Meadow Way, said point being the southeastern most corner of Lot 5 of the Deer Meadow Subdivision and the northeastern most corner of Lot 7 of the Cherry Farms Subdivision.

Thence, with the lines of Lot 7 and Lot 5 of the Cherry Farms Subdivision, the r/w of Deer Meadow Way, and Lots 8, and 47-52 of the Deer Meadow Subdivision the following two calls, S 11°14'54" W a distance of 813.48' to a 1" iron pipe found.

Thence, S 11°13'46" W a distance of 300.40' to a point, said point being the common corner between Lot 52 and Lot 53 of a revision to Deer Meadow Subdivision (Plat Book 27 Page 19) and in the line of Lot 5 of the Cherry Farms Subdivision.

Thence, leaving the line of the Deer Meadow Subdivision and with the line of the corporate limits of the City of Bowling Green and bisecting Lots 5 and 7 of the Cherry Farms Subdivision, N 77°50′55″ W a distance of 278.36′ to a point.

Thence, N 12°04'58" E a distance of 1154.32' to the point of **Beginning**, containing 306,208 square feet (7.03 acres) as surveyed by Arnold Consulting Engineering Services, Inc., Jeff Arnold PLS 2934 on April 15, 2009.
