## ORDINANCE No. 10-87A

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN THE FOLLOWING:

That the said Council does hereby de-annex from the City of Brownsville the following described incorporated territory to wit:

A certain area of land believed to be in the present city limits of Brownsville, Kentucky, and more particularly described as follows:

### (Description)

Beginning at a point on the eastern bank of the mouth of Beaver Dam Creek, ten (10) feet from the low water mark, and on the southern bank of Green River. From this point following the meanderings of the eastern bank of Beaver Dam Creek in a southerly direction to the old town plat line, as marked with a corner stone. Following the old town plat line in a southerly direction to the northern bank of Beaver Dam Creek, as marked with a corner stone. Again following the meanderings of the northern bank in an easterly direction to the existing city limits described in the annexation of 1978. (This point being just north of the bridge over Beaver Dam Creek on Mohawk Road.)

This Ordinance shall become effective on October 22, 19 87. Duly moved, seconded, and passed by the City Council, City of Brownsville, Kentucky, the 1/3th day of October , 19 87.

# ORDINANCE No. 7-87A

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO DE-ANNEX FROM THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE CERTAIN INCORPORATED AREA

The Council of the City of Brownsville, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

That the said Council proposes to de-annex from the City of Brownsville the following described incorporated territory to wit:

A certain area of land believed to be in the present city limits of Brownsville, Kentucky, between Beaver Dam Creek and existing western town plat line, and more particularly described as follows:

(Description)

Beginning at a point on the eastern bank of the mouth of Beaver Dam Creek, ten (10) feet from the low water mark, and on the southern bank of Green River. From this point following the meandering eastern bank of Beaver Dam Creek in a southerly direction to the old town plat line, as marked with a corner stone. Following the old town plat line in a southerly direction to the northern bank of Beaver Dam Creek as marked with a corner stone. Again following the meandering northern bank in an easterly direction to the existing city limits described in the annexation of 1978. (This point being just north of the bridge over Beaver Dam Creek on Mohawk Road.)
