

JUDGMENT:

The petition of Joe Bert Howard, L. A. Solomon, and one hundred and fifty seven other legal voters of Calvert City Kentucky, coming on for hearing and no defense having been interposed thereto and it appearing to the court that the boundaries of said proposed city obtains the required number of legal inhabitants and it further appearing to the court that this proceeding has been duly and legally advertised as required by law. It is, therefore, adjudged that city named and designated as Calvert City and being within the following boundary, to-wit.

beginning at a point on the north side of the school road at the intersection of the school road with the old Calvert City and Gilbertsville road; thence, south on the west side of said road to a point opposite the Joe Houston and Dr. L. E. Smith corner; thence east with Joe Houston and Dr. L. E. Smith line to a stake; thence south with a small ditch to the south right-of-way line of the L. O. R. R. Crossing the R. R at a small sewer; thence west with said right-of-way line to Shemwell Street; thence south with Shemwell Street to the south line of H. H. Kunnecke; thence east with Kunnecke's south line crossing the Calvert City and Big Cypress WPA road and intersecting the line between U. C. Wakley and the North line of Tennessee Valley Land Company addition No. 3 to Calvert City, and continuing on east to the east line of said addition No. 3; thence south with the east line of said addition No. 3, to a point when turned west would be opposite the south line of Z. R. Hall; thence west crossing the Calvert City and Big Cypress WPA road and with the south line of Z. R. Hall, and continuing west to a point when turned north would intersect state street in the Tennessee Valley Land Company Addition No. 1, to Calvert City Kentucky; thence north intersecting state street and continuing north with State Street to a point 50 feet north of the south line of said Addition No. 1, to Calvert City, KY. thence west to the East right-of-way line of Highway No. 35; thence north with said right-of-way line to a point opposite the S. E. corner of Claude Lees yard; thence west with the south line of Claude Lees yard and continuing west to a point in Claude Lees field that when turned north would intersect the west line of J. N. Holland, a point 150 feet west of Boulard Street, with a

including North ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ to 150 feet north of Saverfield Street; thence, east across the E. W. Goodloe property to the east right of way line to highway no. 25; thence north with said right of way line to the North side of School road; thence east with the north line of School road to the beginning.

Be and the same is hereby incorporated as a city of the own class, located in Marshall County, Kentucky.

The court upon its own motion now appoints, J. W. Holland, as Police Judge, C. L. Vasseur, as Marshall, and L. D. Morehead, as assessor of said Calvert City, Kentucky, and does hereby appoint G. L. Drafen, H. W. Ford, D. F. Karnes, M. B. Stice and L. A. Solomon, as trustees of said Calvert City, Kentucky. Each of said officers shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected.

The clerk of this court is hereby ordered and directed to, not later than ten days hereafter, certify a copy of this judgment to the Secretary of the State of Kentucky and this action is stricken from the docket.
