ORDINANCE NO. 91-13

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY INTO THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CALVERT CITY LOCATED ADJACENT TO U.S. HIGHWAY 62

WHEREAS an ordinance stating the intention of the City to annex the referenced real property was passed by the City Council at the first reading on the 11th day of June, 1990; and

WHEREAS an ordinance stating the intention of the City to annex the referenced real property was passed by the City Council of the City of Calvert City, Kentucky at the second reading on the 9th day of July, 1990; and

WHEREAS the aforesaid ordinance stating the intention of the City to annex the referenced real property was made effective by publication pursuant to KRS Chapter 424 on the 11th day of July, 1990; and

WHEREAS sixty (60) days have passed since the enactment of the aforesaid ordinance of intent and no petition meeting the requirements of KRS 81A.420 (2) in opposition to the annexation has been received by the mayor;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CALVERT CITY, KENTUCKY that the following described property is hereby annexed, added to, taken in and made a part of the corporate limits of the City of Calvert City, Marshall County, Kentucky, to wit:

Beginning at a point of interesection of the present corporate limits of Calvert City with the centerline of US 62, said point being approximately 500' east of the intersection of the Purchase Parkway with US 62; thence, in a northeasterly direction with the present corporate limits of Calvert City to the centerline of Fifth Avenue; thence, leaving the present corporate limits and running with the centerline of Fifth Avenue in a southeasterly direction to Little Cypress Creek; thence, in an easterly direction with Little Cypress Creek to its intersection with Cypress Creek; thence, in an easterly direction with Cypress Creek to the north (or west) right of way line of I-24; thence, in a southwesterly direction with said north (or west) right of way line of I-24 to US 62; thence, continuing on the projection of the west I-24 right of way line across US 62 and then continuing in a southwesterly direction with the I-24 west right of way line to the southeast corner of Paul and Hazel Duckett; thence, with the Duckett south line to the southwest corner of the Duckett property; thence, in a northerly direction along the Duckett west line to the south line of James Leigh; thence, in a westerly direction with the Leigh south line to Leigh's southwest corner; thence, in a northerly direction with Leigh's west line to the southeast corner of the property owned by Fred Doty; thence, in a westerly direction with the south line of Fred Doty and its projection to the west right of way line of Lone Valley Road; thence, in a southerly direction with the west right of way line of Lone Valley Road to the southeast corner of property owned by Harry Lewman; thence, in a westerly direction with Lewman's south line to the east boundary of property owned by

Helen Dawes; thence, in a southerly direction with Dawes east line to the Dawes southeast corner; thence, in a westerly direction with Dawes south line to the southeast corner of Larry and Judy Brewer; thence, in a westerly direction with the Brewer south line to the southeast corner of Weldon Peck; thence, in a westerly direction with Peck's south line to the east line of property owned by Bruce and Joann Reynolds; thence, continuing in a westerly direction with the projection of the Peck south line across the Reynold's property to the east right of way line of Palm Street; thence, in a northerly direction with the east right of way line of Palm Street, same being the west line of Reynold, to the intersection of the projection of the south line of property owned by Associated Battery; thence, in a westerly direction with the south line of Associated Battery to the southeast corner of Kenneth, Sandra and Mark Westfall; thence, in a westerly direction with the south line of Westfall to the southeast corner of Paul Harrington, Sr.; thence, in a westerly direction with the Harrington south line to the southeast corner of William R. and Phillip M. Colburn; thence, in a westerly direction with the Colburn south line to Lone Valley Branch, same being the southeast corner of property owned by Albert Futrell; thence, in a westerly direction with the Futrell south line and its projections to the west right of way of the Purchase Parkway; thence, in a southwesterly direction with the west right of way of the Purchase Parkway to an unnamed tributary of Lone Valley Branch; thence, in a northwesterly direction along said unnamed tributary to its intersection with the present corporate limits of the City of Calvert City just west of Laurel Lane; thence, north, east and northeast with the present corporate limits of the City of Calvert City to the point of beginning at the centerline of US 62 approximately 500' east of the Purchase Parkway.

There is excepted from the above-described property, all road rights of way owned by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, County of Marshall County, Kentucky, and the United States of America, and those roadways are not a part of the property annexed.

Upon the passing of this ordinance and publication of same in accordance with KRS Chapter 424, the above described property will be deemed annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Calvert City, Kentucky.
